**SHROPSHIRE JUNIOR CHESS REPORT**  
**JULY 2<sup>nd</sup> 2003**

Three Shropshire Junior teams took part in competitions this year.

The Under 9 team played 3 matches:

1. The Wirral – We lost 12½ to 13½
2. Midlands Championships – 10pts out of 36. Placed 5<sup>th</sup> out of 5
3. Northern Zone – 9½ pts out of 36. Placed 9<sup>th</sup> out of 9.

The Under 11 team played 3 matches:

1. The Wirral – We lost 47½ to 64½
2. Midlands Championships – 15½ pts out of 60. Placed 7<sup>th</sup> out of 7
3. Northern Zone – 28 pts. Placed 6<sup>th</sup> out of 10.

A much better result.

In general, the top boards scored most of the points in each competition, the top 3 scoring 20 points out of a possible 27 over the 3 matches. We lack strength in depth as usual.

The Under 18 team played in the MCCU championships, but could not repeat the feat of last year and get through to the final. My thanks to Keith Fowler for organising the team and transport and to the Under 11 players who stepped in to make up a team. Half of the original selection couldn't play for some reason or other.

Individually we are still doing well. We now have 3 internationals, Simon Fowler, Thomas Pym and Louis Graham. *Jehan Fenton who plays for Wales.* Louis won the England trials, playing mostly against players up to 12 months older. He has I believe been selected to play in the World Championships.

In the UK Chess Challenge 2003, Shropshire children won at least 4 of the sections, with 2 runners-up and a third place as well.
